## **Distance Education Enrollments** at Illinois Colleges and Universities

Data for Summer 2017/Academic Year 2016-2017

## **Executive Summary**

Illinois colleges and universities reported 981,703 enrollments in all distance education delivery modes during academic year 2016-2017. Of those enrollments, 99.16% (973,437) were in online or blended course sections. Interactive TV saw the largest increase for Summer 2017 with online and blended courses remaining constant with a 1% increase from Summer 2016.

## **Online Courses and Enrollments**


Illinois colleges and universities reported **265,263** enrollments during the Summer 2017 term. This is a 1% increase from Summer 2016 term when there were **262,100** enrollments. The enrollments for Academic Year 2016-2017 for online and blended courses were **973,437**. This is a **>1%** increase from Academic Year 2015-2016 when there were **972,738** enrollments.

## **Blended Courses**

This report includes blended course enrollments from all institutions. This request for data shows **14,697** enrollments that account for **5.52%** of all enrollments for Summer 2017. The definition used for blended during this term is 25-75% at a distance.

## **Enrollments in Online Courses**

This graph shows online course enrollments reported by Illinois colleges and universities for the Summer terms from 2009 to 2017.



## **Changes in Enrollment by Delivery Mode**

## **Online and Blended Enrollment Percentage**

Online and blended enrollments accounted for **99.66%** of all distance education enrollments in the Summer 2017 term.

## All Other Delivery Mode Percentage

The Summer 2017 term saw increases in online and blended courses, as well as courses presented via Interactive TV. Table 2 in the Appendix shows the change in distance education enrollments by delivery mode from Summer 2016 to Summer 2017.

## **Online Enrollments by Sector**

## **Community College Enrollment**

During the Summer 2017 term, community colleges reported **73,974** enrollments for **27.89%** of all online course enrollments.

## **Public University Enrollment**

Public universities reported offering 51,998 enrollments for 19.60% of all online course enrollments.

## **Independent For-Profit Colleges and Universities**

Independent for-profit colleges and universities reported offering **120,818** enrollments for **45.55%** of all online course enrollments.


## Independent Not-For-Profit Colleges and Universities

Independent not-for-profit colleges and universities reported **18,473** enrollments for **6.96%** of all online course enrollments.

## Institutions With the Largest Online Enrollments

The Illinois institutions reporting the largest online course enrollments during the Summer 2017 term in each sector of higher education in Illinois were:

- College of DuPage (9,305) and College of Lake County (4,233) from the community college system.
- University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (13,832) and Illinois State University (7,836) from the public universities.
- DeVry University (67,076) from the independent for-profit colleges and universities.
- DePaul University (5,575) from the independent not-for-profit colleges and universities.




## Online Enrollments by Residency

The vast majority of all online course enrollments reported by Illinois public colleges and universities were from students residing in the state. Independent colleges and universities had a majority of online course enrollments from students living in the U.S. outside of Illinois.

The residency of students enrolled in online courses varied by sector, with community colleges having the highest percentage of Illinois residents (96%), followed by public universities (80%) and the independent not-for-profit colleges and universities (80%).

## **Annual Academic Year Enrollments**

Illinois colleges and universities reported a total of **973,437** online course enrollments and **981,703** enrollments in all distance education during academic year 2016-2017 (Fall 2016, Spring 2017 and Summer 2017). This is an increase of 699 online course enrollments **(>1%)** and a decrease of 157 course enrollments **(>1%)** in all distance education delivery modes from the previous academic year (2015-2016).



The State of Illinois greatly appreciates the cooperative effort of all Illinois colleges and universities and the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) in submitting the distance education course enrollment data for this report.
